

For The New Left Party As Soon As Possible

Motion agreed at an All Member Assembly on 13 July 2025.

rs21 believes that:

- While the new left party has seemingly been announced, it nonetheless remains in a prolonged pre-launch state of secret negotiations. As such, would-be party members and branches have no democratic control over its direction and are reduced to lobbying unelected future leadership. At the same time, issues requiring urgent national coordination – such as the continuing rise of Reform in polling, and the proscription of Palestine Action – are met with smaller and localised initiatives.
- Until the new left party is launched, we are not in a position to commit to a full and precise strategy in relation to it.

rs21 resolves that:

- Until the launch of the new left party, organisational interventions from members and the organisation as a whole (in publications, at meetings, and so on) should be focused on pushing for:
 - An end to the secret negotiations and for the public launch of the left party as soon as possible, with a call to form local branches;
 - Neither fudge nor capitulation on opposition to British imperialism, or on trans liberation, migrant rights or any other so-called 'culture war' issue, and;
 - Full democratic membership-control of the new party upon its launch, including one-member-one-vote in any internal elections;
- The SG will release a public statement on the website, emphasising the above points.
